Position Overview:

In collaboration with the University of Windsor, Office of Research and Innovation Services (ORIS), Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry-Windsor Campus, and WE-SPARK Health Institute, the Health Research Associate will work with research teams made up of medical school learners, researchers and clinicians in Windsor-Essex. This position will involve direct participation in research activities, including Research Ethics Board submissions, designing projects, data collection and an opportunity to publish outcomes. The ability to translate the outcomes of health-related research projects to the general public will be expected.

- Minimum Master's degree in health-related field or greater.
- Minimum of one-year research experience, clinical research experience, methodology and statistics training, an asset
- Minimum of one-year project management skills, including tracking and reporting outcomes
- Demonstrated ability in planning and coordinating workshops/events

- Proven ability to work independently with high level of initiative
- Proven ability to work as an effective team member
