

University of Windsor Adjunct Professor Status

BENEFITS



Opens up opportunities to become a Primary Applicant for current and future local grant programs that require UWindsor Affiliation.



Can get involved as a team member on current/future funded research projects.



Ability to apply for external research funding through UWindsor Office of Research and Innovation (ORIS).



Access to Leddy library resources such as research services, collections and research data services through the Academic Data Centre.



Access to UWindsor students who can serve as research staff on the applicant's projects.



If eligible, may be appointed as Affiliate Graduate faculty and serve as co-supervisor for graduate students. Also, can serve as an internal/external department reader in their area of expertise.

HOW TO APPLY



Contact wesparkhealth@uwindsor.ca to begin the application process. WE-SPARK can help match applicants with interested faculty sponsor to or provide recommendations directly to the Department Head.



Must provide a up-to-date curriculum vitae and letter of intent indicating why the applicant would like to be considered for Adjunct Professor status.



The applicant may be invited to conduct a research seminar in the department or school and to meet with faculty and students.



Departmental council will vote on approval of the applicant as an Adjunct Professor.



The candidate will be informed of the outcome by the Department Head who will then forward the nomination to VPRI, Office of Research and Innovation for action and the Dean of Graduate Studies.

To Have ADJUNCT STATUS You Need To

1

Hold a MD or PhD in a relevant field or have demonstrated prior equivalent experience

2

Be able to demonstrate a high level of research capability

3

Have a significant academic interaction with one or more Faculty members
