 Access to Leddy library resources such as research services, collections and research data services through the Academic Data Centre.



HOW TO APPLY



 Contact wesparkhealth@uwindsor to begin. We can help match applicants with interested faculty, or provide recommendations to directly to the Department Head.





 Provide a current CV and Letter of Intent indicating why you would like to be considered for adjunct status.



 You may be invited to conduct a research seminar in the department/school and meet with faculty and students.



Departmental Council will vote on the approval of the application.

You will be informed of the outcome by the Department Head. If approved, your nomination will then be forwarded to the VP Research & Innovation, ORIS and the Dean of Graduate Studies for action.

APPOINTMENT CRITERIA



 Hold a MD or PhD in a relevant field, or have demonstrated equivalent experience.



 Be able to demonstrate a high level of research capability.



 Have a significant interaction with one or more faculty members.
